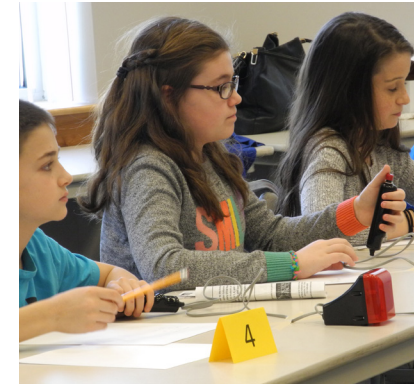

Three Areas of Opportunity

1. Academic Competitions

IU13 emphasizes the need for strategic, higher-level thinking at all grade levels. IU13 hosts academic competitions which bring students together from many schools to develop self-confidence, problem-solving abilities, and leadership.

Each year, hundreds of elementary, middle, and high school students compete at IU13 in academic challenges such as:

SEE Seminars provide innovative, interactive, and thought-provoking programs for gifted students, Grades 4-12, throughout Lancaster and Lebanon counties. The program offers a wide variety of topics and experiences not readily available in the regular classroom.
